

### MEETINGHOUSE LANE, WOODHOUSE, SHEFFIELD

#### BRIEF HISTORY

Religion in and around Woodhouse dates back to the Roman and Saxon period, but to keep on the path of the Quakers, one must move forward in time to the mid 17 century.

The Friends Meetinghouse is situated on the eastern side of the village and is known to be the oldest place of worship in Woodhouse, dating back to 1680. Parts of the ground occupied by the Meetinghouse and the burial ground were contributions given by such people as; William Milner of Door house, giving 100 square yards, Thomas Taylor donated £52-15s, Godfrey Newbold gave 8 perches (approx 5 yards per perch) being part of Lamb Croft, to be used as a burial ground.

In 1697 Godfrey Newbold gave (in trust) 14 perches to Sir John Rhodes, Godfrey Newbold Jnr, Robert Haslam and Robert Hazzlehurst, also part of Lamb Croft to be used for the burial ground, Meetinghouse and a stable.

Over the next two centuries, despite hostilities towards the Quakers and imprisonment to some of it's members, the movement grew and grew due to increase in population, so therefore extensions were added to the original building. The prominent dates are 1807 over top of the scraper, 1858 can be seen over the porch, and from the front of the building the foundation stone over top of the door way (North wall) dating back to 1880, two hundred years after the first erection.

After a life span of exactly three hundred years, the decision to close and sell the Meetinghouse was decided at the Woodhouse meeting on 12th October 1980. This act was inevitable due to the fall in attendance of members and the financial burden of the upkeep of the Meetinghouse. The old Meetinghouse was finally converted into private residence, which it remains today.

The outcome of the sale of the old Meetinghouse would mean that the burial ground would become part of the residence, so therefore the headstones were removed and a walled area was designated to house the stones. At the rear of this register are two plans of the burial ground, one plan is of the original shape and size, the second is as the burial ground is today.


