Edward Ramsey Allen F3 149 Anglican Edward R Allen died in 1902. He doesn't seem to have had any family but he was a respected member of the Veterans' Association and had served in the 3rd West York Militia and the 7th Fusiliers. He saw 'much' service in the Crimean Campaign, the Indian Mutiny and the North West Frontier Campaign. Returning to England in 1870, he joined the First Class Army Reserve and after 26 years' service was discharged in 1882 with four medals and a pension of eleven and a half pence per day for life. It was not enough. At the age of 53 he took work as a labourer in various iron works but his **obituary in the Sheffield Daily Telegraph (May 28, 1902)** adds 'in times of need he received help from the fund of the Veterans' Association'. He was buried in a public grave.
